OVERVIEW



Probably the best way to see the City by the Bay is this year's INTER-NOISE banquet dinner cruise on San Francisco Bay. The cruise starts from Pier 3 on San Francisco's Embarcadero providing a magnificent



view of the City skyline. The cruise continues out to the Golden Gate Bridge passing underneath about sunset time. Heading back to into the Bay, the cruise passes by landmarks such as Angel Island, Alcatraz, Treasure Island, the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge, and the San Francisco Giants AT&T Park. The cruise ends with a nighttime view of the City as the ship returns to Pier 3.

THE YACHT CALIFORNIA

Custom built in New Orleans in 1988, the California is one of the West Coast's largest and most luxurious dining yachts. Patterned after turn of the century steamships that sailed the



California coast, the California was constructed to blend the classic and the contemporary. This 183 foot vessel accommodates up to 500 passengers for dinner events. The California features three spacious



climate controlled decks, mahogany bars, expansive promenade decks and a sky deck atop the vessel. Other shipboard features include an elegant foyer on the main deck, windows with panoramic views, and brass, teak and mahogany appointments. All cuisine is freshly prepared on board by talented chefs in the ship's professional galley and served by uniformed stewards. Congress delegates and accompanying persons will be seated at tables graced with linens, china and brass lanterns.

INFORMATION

- Three course dinner with wine or beer included (cash bar additional)
- The cruise is from 1900 to 2200 on Tuesday 11 August
- Buses begin leaving from the Marriott Marquis at 1730 for the 10 to 15 minute ride
- If so inclined, walking time is about 25 minutes
- Cost is 150 USD per person for registered accompanying persons and Congress delegates
- Consider jackets or coats if you plan to be out on deck as it can be breezy
